Report from County Councillors Cllr Ashton reported that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Phase 3 of the work in South Street, Crewkerne was due to start on 15 July and should be completed within two weeks. The junction with Kit Hill is closed during this period. • The new elected MP for Yeovil, Adam Dance, will be staying on a Somerset Councillor but will no longer be a portfolio holder. • Yeovil Town Council will take over the running of the sports complex in Mudford Road from Somerset Council. No decision has yet ben reached about the future of the Octagon Theatre. • He is investigating the claim that South West Coaches will be running limited services (affecting North Perrott, Misterton and Crewkerne Train Station) until late September. • The planning application for 180 houses at Kithill has been turned down by SC Planning Department. Substantial objections were received from First Great Western, Wessex Water and Highways.
